**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 **International Laser Class Rules** will apply with one exception. Sail number rules will be waived, however all competitors must have a sail number that is unique within this competition.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Radial Rig Lasers Sailors must be current members of the Bermuda Laser Class (\$25 for 2008)
- 2.2 Entry Fee will be \$25, payable at registration.

**3 REGISTRATION**

- 3.1 Registration will be at SPBC on November 29th prior to the start of the first race.

**4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Dates of racing:

29 November 11-0-Clock.  
30 November 11-0-Clock.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 11-0-clock
- 4.3 A maximum of 8 races will be sailed.

**6.1** The sailing area will be the Great Sound or the waters of North Shore off Spanish Point

## **7 QUALIFICATION FOR REGATTAS**

**7.1** The top female qualifies for the 2009 Laser Radial Worlds.

**7.2** The top Girl (must be under the age of 19 on December 31st 2009) qualifies for the 2009 ILCA Youth Worlds Championships in Radials and the 2009 ISAF Youth Worlds single handed dinghy female position.

**7.3** The top Boy (must be under the age of 19 on December 31st 2009) qualifies for the 2009 ILCA Youth Worlds Championships in Radials and the 2009 ISAF Youth Worlds single handed dinghy male position.

**7.4** The top Male qualifies for the 2009 Laser Radial Mens Worlds

**7.5** The top two sailors qualify for the 2009 Island Games in Radial rig.
