NOTICE OF RACE

The Royal Hamilton Amateur Dinghy Club (R.H.A.D.C.), their Officers, Members and Employees bear no responsibility for accidents, damage or injuries to boats or their crew however so caused during or related to this regatta. Attention is drawn to ISAF RRS 4 (Decision to Race)

- Invitation** The Royal Hamilton Amateur Dinghy Club (R.H.A.D.C.) is pleased to invite all sailors to compete in the R.H.A.D.C. Frostbite Series.
- Classes** Eligible classes will be Laser, Laser Radial, 420, Snipe and Byte. Starts shall be given for classes registering 2 or more boats.
- Entries** Eligible boats may be entered by submitting the following to R.H.A.D.C. Sailing Office:
a) a completed entry form - on or before taking part in racing;
b) \$30 Entry fee payment per boat;
c) \$45 Storage fee payment per boat if storage required at RHADC facilities.
Skippers failing to do so, will not be scored until payment is made.
- Sail numbers** For all classes, sail numbers shall be the same during the regatta. Sail numbers changes must be notified in writing to the Race Committee or Sailing Office, at least 48 hours prior to the racing day. Skippers failing to do so may not be scored.
- Laser Standard Class** For the Laser Standard class either radial or standard sails may be used. Competitors are free to choose which sail they will use on any racing day. Sail numbers on both sails must be the same. Competitors registering in this class will be scored only in this class.
- Laser Radial Class** A Laser Radial sail shall be used.
- Charter Boats** The RHADC has 8 420's for charter. If you are interested please contact the Sailing Office and book your charter boat.
- Rules** The regatta shall be governed by "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS).
- Sailing Instructions** The sailing instructions will be available at R.H.A.D.C. under the Official Notice Board.
- Check in** On each day of racing, before the start of the first race or when arriving to the race area; each participating boat must sail on starboard tack by the stern of the Race Committee boat and make sure the R.C. takes note of the sail number and skipper's name.
- General** The racing area will be the waters of Hamilton Harbour.
- Scoring & Prizes** The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. There shall be one discard for each five completed races to score a days racing, and one discard for every two races to score the series and the overall. Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class for each series, and for the Overall Series.
- Schedule of Races** Racing is scheduled as follows:

- Ten races shall be scheduled per day. One race shall be completed to constitute a series. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1:00pm each Sunday.
- Storage** Storage at R.H.A.D.C. for boats is available from November 27th, 2006 through March 5th, 2007 for \$45 payable in advance. Boats left at the R.H.A.D.C. after March 5th –will be charged for the month of March. The Royal Hamilton Amateur Dinghy Club (R.H.A.D.C.), their Officers, Members and Employees bear no responsibility for accidents, damage or injuries to boats however so caused whilst stored at R.H.A.D.C.
- Social** Sailors are invited to R.H.A.D.C. after racing where complimentary bar snacks will be served. Prize-giving will be held at R.H.A.D.C. at 6:00pm on February 25th, 2007
